1. Cause and Effect: This passage describes how programming bugs affect computers.
2. Compare and Contrast: This passage discusses how input and output are similar and different.
3. Sequence: This paragraph describes some of the steps that will lead to contracting a computer virus.
4. Problem and Solution: This paragraph tells readers how they can protect themselves (solution) against computer viruses (problem).
5. Cause and Effect: This paragraph gives reasons (causes) why people might want to infect computers with viruses (effect).
6. Compare and Contrast: This paragraph describes similarities and differences between receiving WiFi and mobile data.
7. Chronological Order: This paragraph tells readers about some important milestones in computer sales based on the order in which the events happened.
8. Sequence: This paragraph teaches readers a method to saving money on the purchase of a computer.
9. Compare and Contrast: This paragraph discusses similarities and differences between tablets and PCs.
10. Problem and Solution: This paragraph teaches readers to avoid pains brought on by heavy computer use (problem) by taking frequent breaks and stretching (solution).
